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



Going Green with RECP


Residents of NASWI family housing have demonstrated their understanding of the importance of conserving energy. In the past three years, side-by-side comparisons show residents have decreased their average consumption by approximately 20% per home. The savings is enough to run a 100-watt lightbulb for 1,900 hours and heat a 350-degree oven for almost 200 hours. The combined savings is enough to run 1,530 100-watt lightbulbs for more than 1,800 hours each and heat over 1,360 350-degree

ovens for over 20 hours each. Hunt Companies and Navy family housing are proud of our residents for taking the initiative to save energy and demonstrate the importance of conserving.


