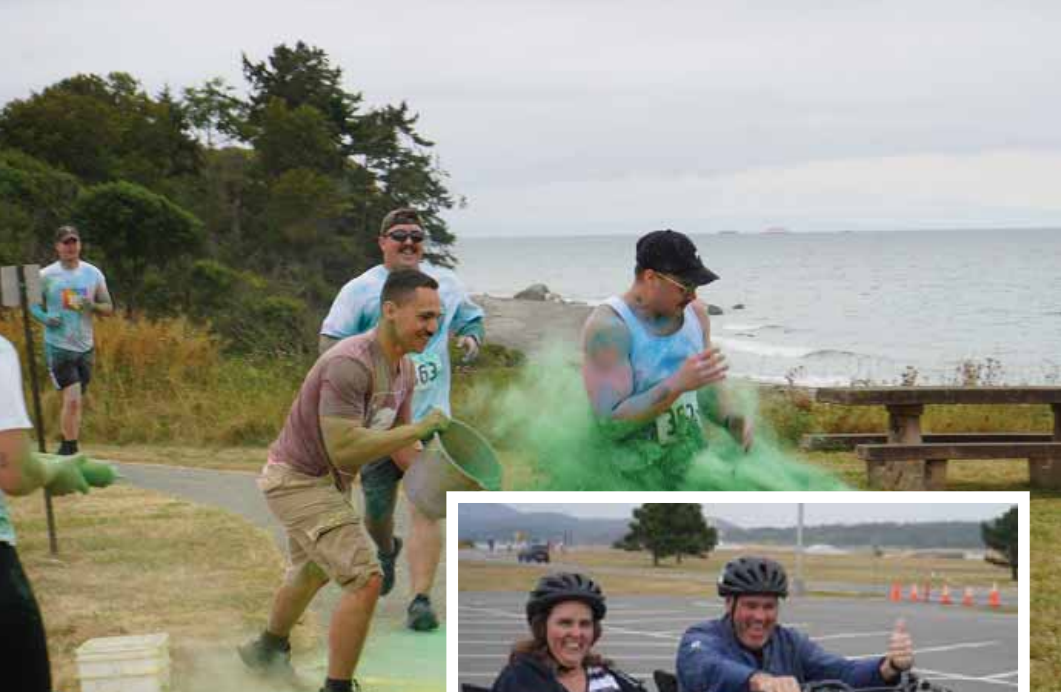

SERIOUS FUN: MWR'S Event M

Fleet & Family Readiness recognizes the burdens that service members and their families shoulder during times of service. It's why providing high-quality services from programs like MWR matters so much. These events, classes and activities are designed to enhance the quality of life and provide meaningful experiences that service members and their families experience during their time in the Pacific Northwest.

"The first event I ever worked on was the Ride to Remember 12-mile bike race in Guam," NAS Whidbey Island Fitness Manager, Jennifer Baker says. "I learned a lot when planning for that event that I use today."

Events may appear seamless to attendees, but they require extensive coordination behind the scenes. Looking behind the curtain

reveals the many hands involved, like Jennifer's, in ensuring events run smoothly and remain enjoyable year after year for service members across Navy Region Northwest.

From idea to execution, event planning for large events can take months, mapping out budget, staffing and logistics with careful attention to detail.

"We usually meet about three-to-four months prior to the event to discuss the event and go over the layout," NAS Whidbey Island Event and Conference Center Manager Melissa Bevill says. "Then again usually about a month out for staffing purposes."

Once logistics are finalized, coordination shifts into high gear. Teams from multiple departments collaborate to share resources, including supplies,

venues and personnel. In the days leading up to an event, staff focus on final preparations and troubleshooting last-minute details.

"It's all hands-on-deck," Bevill says. "One team, one fight. We work together for setup, tear down and the cleanup for the days to follow. There are a lot of logistics to maneuver for our events."

The culmination of the hard work is running the event itself and ensuring patrons enjoy their guest experience. Even while events are underway, staff remain actively engaged to ensure everything runs smoothly and patrons are enjoying themselves. When the last guests depart, work continues through cleanup, feedback collection,

and post-event evaluation, all in preparation for future improvements.

“Our team’s philosophy is built on collective effort, where every role – from cooking to guest services – has a significant impact on the patron experience,” NAS Whidbey Island Recreational Facilities Manager Cherry Laverdure says. “While it’s difficult to single out one person, a stand-out example of our team’s synergy is how they respond to unexpected challenges. For instance, during a sudden downpour at an outdoor event, our staff worked to quickly and cheerfully guide patrons to shelter, maintaining high morale and ensuring guest comfort. It’s this collective dedication that truly defines our team’s positive interaction with patrons.”

From managers to volunteers, every role plays a part in delivering meaningful experiences for Sailors and their families.



“While it’s exciting to execute a flawless event, I also find great value when we face challenges, as those moments provide the most important lessons for future growth,” Laverdure says. “Ultimately, knowing we created a positive and memorable experience for the community – regardless of the event’s scale – is the biggest reward.”

Bevill often reminds her team of simple but effective guidance to help ensure success for every event.

“Just breathe, take one customer at a time and most of all, have fun doing your job.” ■



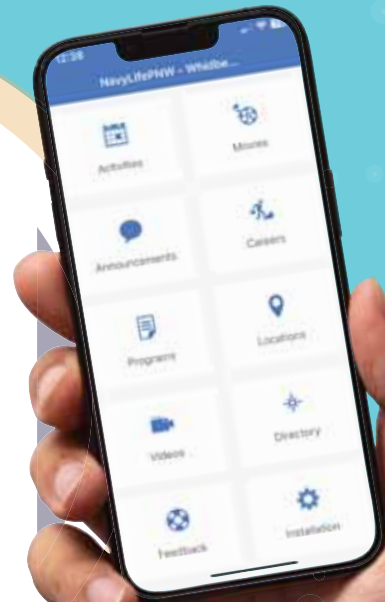

We also offer regularly scheduled team sports leagues and opportunities to participate in tournaments and regional sports competitions throughout the year. This includes the Admiral's Cup, the Captain's Cup and All-Navy Sports, a program for Sailors who possess the athletic skills to compete above the intramural level to compete against teams from the Marine Corps, Army and Air Force.

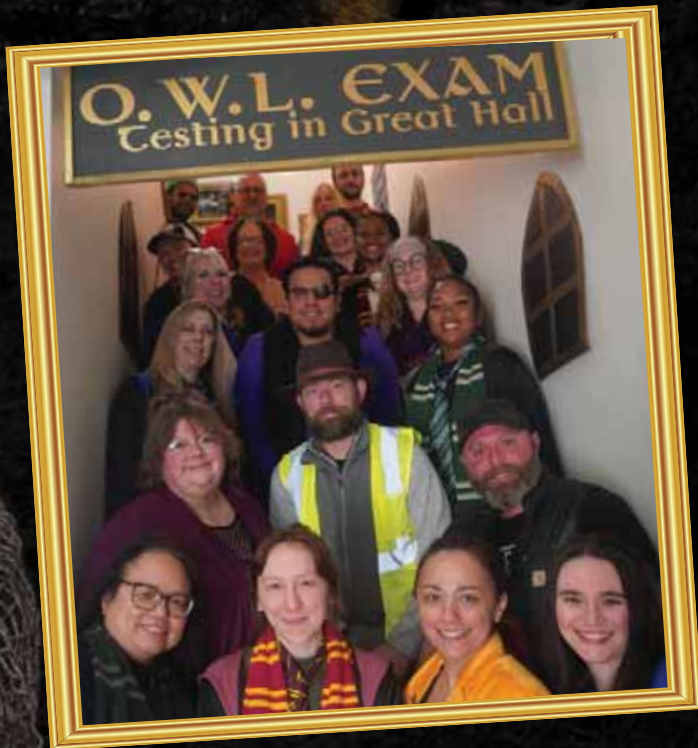

The event started as an effort to create winter programming that would appeal to a broad range of families. At the time, Summer Dahozy was serving as the NS Everett Outdoor Recreation Programmer and working alongside Ryan Leavy, then the Community Recreation Manager. After exploring several theme ideas – including a prehistoric adventure and fantasy video game world – the team found that the magical school theme resonated most strongly with the community, and the Wizarding World of Jim Creek was born.

"The magic over the last decade is that it has blended imagination with reality," Summer says. "It has been the most widely attended event year after year. That





is why we've continued it for these past ten years."

Looking back at the first event, it was much smaller in scale than what visitors see today. Summer and Ryan had always hoped to expand it over time, and they approached that growth gradually, adding new features each year. Their careful, step-by-step approach has turned the event into a detailed, immersive environment that feels almost like a professionally designed set.

Despite the event's growth, its core traditions remain magically the same. The main "shops", featuring handcrafted wands and sweet treats, have been part of the experience since the beginning. In an era dominated by mass production, Jim Creek remains committed to its roots and

hands-on craftsmanship. Each wand is made by hand, spun from wooden dowels, glue and paint. The work begins months in advance and is completed just as the first visitors arrive.

For year 10, the creative team added a magical shop for guests to procure their favorite joke and novelty gifts, bringing a new level of play to the experience.

If you ask Summer to describe the event in one word, she chooses "immersive."

"Everyone gets to be a wizard student for one day," Summer says. "They create potions, get candy from our own dessert emporium, have a wand choose them, and attend herbology class to plant new friends."

Fascination and excitement are the secrets to the event's longevity. Parents who grew up reading the books are now sharing that same enthusiasm brought to life with their children.

"When we see every guest enjoying the experience and finding joy in the tiny details, it makes the team proud," Summer says.

But for Summer and her crew, the true magic isn't in the wands or the potions, or even the pride the team feels in its own work. It's in the smiles of the families who have made Jim Creek and this charmed event their magical home for the last 10 years. ■

ROOMS AND REALLY FEELING AT HOME AWAY FROM HOME, WITH UNACCOMPANIED HOUSING RECONNECT

In a career in which the next destination for service members often changes, so does the place they call home. For some, that home looks like an aircraft carrier or a submarine while underway. For many young, single service members, home is often found in Unaccompanied Housing.

With a mission to provide a “home away from home,” staff at Unaccompanied Housing strive to offer quality services and accommodations throughout a service member’s tour in the Pacific Northwest. Service members arriving to UH are provided with a housing assignment, points of contact for housing-related questions, a bedding kit and other essential living items.

Building Managers are among the first staff members on deck to assist service members with their transition, helping ensure the process of getting settled into a new living space is seamless. Their role centers on maintaining UH as a safe, clean and secure environment with comfortable accommodations for each resident.

“By taking a personal interest in tenants and streamlining maintenance ... their living space becomes a source of comfort, not stress,” UH Complex Manager Dennis Guerrero says. “This reliable support system makes sailors feel cared for and secure in their environment.”

When Sailor Adryen Hall arrived at NAS Whidbey Island for the first

time, he had the option to continue living on the ship or move into UH. He viewed UH as a temporary alternative and reprieve from shipboard life. The opportunity allowed him to create a living space of his own, something he explained is limited while residing aboard an aircraft carrier.

Adryen says he looked forward to customizing his room and working with his roommate to transform it into a personalized space.

“I appreciate the freedom to move things around and decorate my room, within reason,” he says. “I appreciate the opportunity to be creative and to be able to express myself inside my room.”

Thinking back to his own experience as a UH resident, Dennis says he appreciated the benefits of living on base.

“What I valued most was the incredible camaraderie we built by living together,” he says. “The easy access to essential amenities like the commissary and the NEX was also a major advantage that made life much more convenient.”

Originally from Chicago, Ill., Adryen notes that living in UH has also given him the opportunity to connect with service members working in roles he may not have crossed paths with otherwise.

“It does help with the opportunity to engage in activities with a different person from a different culture,” he says. “I get along with my roommate pretty well. We spend a lot of time together, which fostered a deep bond between us.”

Unaccompanied Housing serves as a temporary residence for hundreds of service members across each installation, but it is more than just living quarters. Life in UH provides a home base where service members can form friendships and create lasting memories during their time in the Pacific Northwest. ■
