UH RESIDENTS TASKING DURING FALL SEASON.

1. Since Room Heaters (steam) will be turned on, leaks sometimes follow when pipe con-
densation is forced out so please report any leaks right away.
2. Report any burnt Light Bulbs, Hallway Light not working because dark hours will get
longer now.
3. Arrange your furniture so air circulation is better to prevent Mildew.
4. Once in a while on a sunny day, open your windows and air your room.
5. Always keep your room clean, it will discourage bugs from coming in.
6. Since cold temperatures are starting to creep in, Bugs will be doing the same, because
your room is a lot warmer than outside. Report any appearance of Ants, Spiders, or any
bugs so we can call the base Pest Control before it gets worse.



Smoke Detectors

Please do not remove or
tamper with Smoke De-
tectors, they are there
not only to protect you
but all the residents in
the building. Tamper-
ing with them is a Fed-
eral Offense and you are
liable to pay for replace-
ment or repair.

UH Policy Violations

2 Alcohol Incidents resulted in Command implementing corrective measures including restriction

2 Complaints of excessive noise resulted in Command implementing corrective measures including restriction

Violation for unauthorized weapon, narcotics, fireworks, and pet resulted in Non Judicial Punishment– reduction in rank and separation from service.

Although we generally act with good intentions, sometimes we stray from that expected good order and discipline and are held responsible for our actions.

Represent and act accordingly!



Bicycle registration is a must! Bicycles left in the bike storage or rack of UH must be registered at building 973 (NGIS). Owners must notify the Front Desk when permanently departing the installation or transferring bicycle ownership for proper clearance of bicycle registration.

UH Guest Policy. Guests are defined as people invited into UH by a UH resident. Guest are permitted in UH provided that they do not interfere with good order and discipline or are an inconvenience to other residents. All guests must be registered at the building quarter deck. Visitation hours will be followed per Resident Handbook. A guest is subject to the rules and regulations of UH and will comply with all orders and instructions from personnel acting in an official capacity. Residents are responsible for his/her guests at all times.



We live in Washington State that is known for rain. If you will be away for more than a day, please remember to close your windows. You never know when it will rain in our area; and the expensive cost to replace furniture or carpet damaged by water will be your responsibility.

REMEMBER, CALL THE FRONT DESK AS SOON AS YOU SEE ANY KINDS OF INSECT OR PEST IN YOUR ROOM. TRACK DOWN WHERE THEY COULD HAVE POSSIBLY ACCESS THE ROOM FROM AND WHERE YOU FOUND THEM TO ENSURE THAT THERE IS NO INFESTATION. DO NOT PUT ANY KIND OF INSECTICIDES OR RODENTICIDES AS OUR CONTRACTOR USES NAVY APPROVED PRODUCTS ONLY.
