

Any Getaways Jim Creek continues to raise the bar on exceptional hospitality. Over the last five years, this Navy-operated recreation facility, nestled in the foothills of the North Cascades, has become a staple attraction in the Pacific Northwest, drawing thousands of visitors annually. We asked two veteran Jim Creek families to tell us more about what keeps them coming back time and time again.

What led to your first visit?

Ryan and Jennifer Roberson were first drawn by the scenery. "We loved it so much, after we had children, we have made it a tradition to take our kids as often as possible," says Roberson, who comes every year for the fishing derby "rain or shine!" The Cardenas family first visited Jim Creek while they were stationed at NAS Whidbey Island after seeing a social media post for Jim Creek's FREE Family Fun Day. "The kids could climb the Alpine Tower and do other activities, so it seemed like something fun to do," says Andre Cardenas, a retired Navy Senior Chief and father of three.

"The reality for us here is that we are on a budget and there often isn't extra to do super fun things together as a family. Jim Creek makes that possible for us," says Cardenas, who regularly attends Jim Creek's special events, which are usually free of charge. The Robersons are fans of friendly competition: "We love when they do contests ... our family really gets into it and we have a wonderful time bonding through working together,"

says Roberson. "One of my favorite times is when they do the Christmas decorating competition, we spend the entire Friday decorating and listening to Christmas music and then the next day enjoying all the festivities MWR has put on. It's truly magical."

Career Capstone

Completion of this activity demonstrates that service members have met their Career Readiness Standards (CRS) and have received the transition services mandated by Department of Defense.

Car Buying

Want to buy a new set of wheels? This workshop educates learners on the three deals of car buying: the purchase,

the financing and the trade-in, plus legal issues and laws. Learn about researching a car purchase, determining how much you can afford and negotiating effectively. Learn the three parts to a car deal and how to get the most for your money.

Career Exploration and Planning

Identify your individual skills and talents, and develop long-term professional goals.

Career Options & Navy Skills Evaluation Program (CONSEP)

This course gives Sailors the tools to make informed decisions about their career options and develop long-term professional goals. The 21st Century CONSEP course provides six modules of instructor-led training that support the Military Life Cycle (MLC) model. Available in two versions: first-term and mid-career Sailors.

Caring for Aging Parents

Are your parents getting older and unsure how you can help? This workshop provides education and resources to assist families in caring for parents as they age, including the financial, emotional and legal issues involved.

CFS Refresher

Learners are refreshed on the financial planning worksheet, the 8-step counseling model, and discuss financial hot topics. This workshop is required per OPNAVINST 1740.5D and CFSs must attend a minimum of every three years.

Command Financial Specialist (CFS) Basic Training

The purpose of this class is to educate and train future Command Financial Specialists in how to best help other Sailors within their commands.

Command Financial Specialist (CFS)/ Leadership Forum

This forum provides members with an opportunity to discuss financial hot topics and current initiatives.

Communication Skills

Communication is powerful and directly affects our quality of life and relationships. Our ability to express what we think and feel without clouding our ability to listen and respect how others think and feel is the greatest factor of success in our work and home life. Yet, communication is an everyday activity that is easily taken for granted. This workshop helps people use the power of communication to strengthen relationships at work and at home by practicing skills that build effective twoway communication.

Conflict Resolution

Unmanaged conflict has caused many hardships in the workplace and at home. It can cause people to suffer, missions to fail and families to separate. Yet, conflict is inevitable. This workshop helps people to manage conflict by examining their attitudes and behaviors when faced with conflicting situations; practicing skills that prevent conflict from escalating, and working with others to solve problems, allowing people to grow, missions to succeed and families to strengthen.

Credit ... What's the Big Deal?

Is credit really that important? This workshop looks at how credit is used, who can access it and why it's important to use credit responsibly.

Dealing with Difficult People

This course provides information about interacting with the challenging people in our lives. This course identifies types of difficult people and elements of effectively communicating with them. The focus will be on five key areas for solving your people problems. We will also address nine tools that are useful in managing difficult relationships.

Debt Rehab

Is debt weighing you down? Unsure where to start? This workshop explores all types of debt from credit card to installment loans to collections and helps you design a recovery plan that best benefits you.

Entrepreneurship Track (B2B)

Two-day workshop for transitioning service and family members interested in starting their own business. In cooperation with the Small Business Administration, this workshop can assist service members in developing a business plan based on a self-assessment and marketing research.

Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP) Command POC

This class discusses the benefits of the EFMP program, the enrollment process for eligible sponsors, and the role of the Command POC in facilitating navigation through the EFM program.

Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP) Roundtable and Training

The Roundtable is a chance for EFMP stakeholders to discuss any issues or questions about the program. There is advance training at each session.

Emotional Intelligence

Emotional Intelligence is the ability to recognize and assess the emotional temperature in social and workplace settings. 
