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Winter can bring a variety of weather challenges, especially in colder climates. Here are some key tips to help you stay safe and comfortable:

- ✓ Layer Up: Be sure to dress warmly in layers, especially when heading outside. Keep extra blankets and warm clothing handy in your room.
- ✓ Room Maintenance: We're here to help! If you notice any drafts, heating issues, or maintenance needs in your room, please report them promptly. For routine maintenance, use the QR code on your door. For urgent and emergency issues, call the Front Desk at 360-257-5513/4163.
- Emergency Supplies: Ensure you have a small supply of essentials (water, nonperishable food, and a flashlight) in case of inclement weather or power outages.
- Road Safety: If you're traveling during the winter months, check road conditions, use winter tires if possible, and always carry an emergency kit in your vehicle.

RESIDENT ADVISOR PROGRAM

Do you know who your RA is?

Each building has assigned RAs to mentor, counsel and assist in maintaining good order and discipline; as well as accelerate adaptation of junior service members to their military life.

RAs are typically in pay grades E6-E9, have gone through the Unaccompanied Housing Assignment Review Board (UHARB) process and approved by the Installation CO, before given the position. You might notice them walking around the building after working hours to ensure nothing is out of the ordinary.
