EFMP IDENTIFICATION & ENROLLMENT

MILITARY TREATMENT FACILITY (MTF) EFMP COORDINATORS

Serving adults and children

EFMP enrollment ensures assignments where there is available specialty care and services for the Exceptional Family Member.

Facilitates the review of initiating enrollments, updates, renewals, and disenrollments.

- Form DD2792 EFMP Medical Enrollment, health services, accommodations, etc.
- Form DD2792-1 EFMP Educational Enrollment, for an Individual Family Service Plan (IFSP) from Early Intervention Services or the Individualized Education Program (IEP) from schools only.

Serving adults and children

Navigating a range of disability-related systems and promote a culture of learning and community of well-being. We partner with families to learn their unique perspective and ideas, to identify coordinating action steps for their goals.

- Service Plans with family's goals and coordinated action steps in these systems of care.
- Installation Housing priority and accommodations
- Access to Specialty Care - coverage, referrals, ECHO services, medical case management, INCAP secondary dependency, dental
- In Home Support - EFMP Respite, ECHO Home Health Care, Adult & Child State Medicaid Home & Community Based Waivers
- Social Security programs - Supplemental Security Income, Social Security Disability Insurance, Medicare
- Vocational Rehabilitation services for youth and adults
- Paratransit, disabled parking
- EFMP-related personnel actions - enrollment, stabilization, HUMS, ERD, leave programs
- Information & Estate planning referrals - Military survivor benefits for EFMP, special needs trusts, ABLE plans, supported living agreement, guardianship, and emergency preparedness
- Activities & classes for EFMP Families and coordinate with EFMP Command POCs
- Information & Referral on completing EFMP medical enrollment form DD2792 and education enrollment DD2792-1 for an IFSP from Early Intervention Services or an IEP from schools.
- Information & Referrals how to initiate an early intervention services evaluation/birth to three and a special education evaluation with schools
- Information & Referrals to School Liaisons for school policies and processes & to Region Special Education Liaison for specialized IEP/504 support.

EFMP SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES REGIONAL SPECIAL EDUCATION LIAISON

Serving EFMP Children & Youth

Learning from each EFMP family about their student and their educational progress, understanding of laws, and support skill building in applied critical thinking and constructive communication in the process, and the benefits of a collaborative IFSP/IEP/504 team.

Training for families in Early Intervention, Special Education, & Accommodations including strength-based parent input, challenging goals, advancing and monitoring progress, etc. Supports families by phone or virtually with IFSP, IEP, 504 to positively supports parent's vision for their student's education and partnership with their school:

- Educational Accommodation Plan (504)
- Transition from and IFSP to and IEP at age 3
- Individualized Education Program (IEP)
- Post-secondary IEP at age 16
- IEP services missed due to medical absences or special service staff absences
- Associated Individual Health Plans (nursing), Emergency Care Plans (rescue meds)
- To appropriately support, please provide the last IFSP/IEP/504 document or if received a draft for an upcoming meeting.
- Information & Referrals to EFMP Case Liaisons and School Liaisons
- If formal grievance, will review various options with the family & coordinate referrals further



CHILD & YOUTH PROGRAMS SCHOOL LIAISONS

Supporting all military connected families and schools

- SME for command regarding pre-K - 12 education
- Assisting Families with Inbound/outbound school transfer
- Providing information on Local schools and boundaries
- Assisting with school choice
- Providing information on home schooling regulations
- Providing information about graduation requirements
- Providing military and community agency referrals
- Special education system navigation - information & referrals to EFMP military on active orders and State Parent Training Information Center for military connected
- Assist with post-secondary preparation
- Youth sponsorship program
- Deployment support (families, ombudsman, FRG, deployment nights)
- In Partnership with Schools: Support school teams with military child transition support and resources, deployment support (including school based MFLCs), the Interstate Compact, and Partnerships in Education



LEGISLATIVE REFERENCES FOR STUDENTS WITH MEDICAL CONDITIONS

Levels the Playing Field

American Disabilities Act (ADA) identifies all EFMs.

Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act

Requires schools to provide Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) including health-related services and activities, i.e. Emergency Care Plan (ECP), Individual Health Plan (IHP), and Educational Accommodation Plan (504).

Maximizes Education Potential, Special Services

Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA)

Conditions adversely affect educational performance. FAPE in Least Restrictive Environment. Parents participate meaningfully. IDEA Part B - Individualized Education Program (IEP), Ages 3-21. IDEA Part C- Individual Family Services Plan (IFSP), Ages 0-3.
